What is still unfinished?

- Two floors of classrooms should be strongly concreted. This allows the Worms that penetrate through the skin into the tissue of the feet and thus inflammation eliminate cause
- Due to the increasing number of children new and larger classrooms should be created.
- Existing pupils banks are unsuitable for younger children, they would have their size match

- There is a lack storage space for school supplies for children and teachers
- Transparent corrugated panels on the roof for more light in the classrooms

The growth of children is greater than that provided by the finances. Still want to give them access not refuse. Jesus also had an open heart for children (Luk.18: 16)

So there are some children for whom no sponsors have yet been found. It would be great for this Kids to have someone who will be a great blessing for them for a modest monthly fee can.
